

We are looking forward to your arrival for the Fin and Feather Camp Weekend! This email provides some of the additional details and Frequently Asked Questions about the upcoming Camp. ACCOMMODATIONS & PROVISIONS FAQS

- *Is breakfast provided or available at the lodge on Saturday & Sunday?* No. Snacks are available for purchase at Lodge during breakfast hours and most units have kitchens or essentials in them.
- Are snacks and drinks provided during the adventures? No. Dinner and box lunch is included in the Camp Fee.
 Other snacks and all beverages are on your own. We have many options available at the Lodge for carryout of for enjoyment at the Lodge.
- Will we need sleeping bags or bedding? No. All linens and bedding is provided.
- *Is there a refrigerator, freezer and stove in the rooms for use?* Yes. Most rooms are fully equipped. Some rooms have limited options and some units have full kitchens. If you desire a full kitchen, please let us know upon registration. We also have freezers for storing game.
- What food is included? Two dinners and box lunches are included in your Camp Fee. Beverages during dinner and during other times can be paid or will be charged to your room.
- What activities are available after dinner each night? Besides some good wing shooting talks, bonfires are a tradition at Trappers Landing Lodge, so we will bring plenty of marshmallows and fun!
- Can dogs come? Dogs are welcome! The more the merrier. Dogs may stay inside selected pet-friendly cabins. They will need be crated over night when inside cabins and will remain in the entry areas.
- How are we grouped? Throughout the Camp, we will be working together and enjoying the activities as teams, much like we would for any fishing, golf or hunting trip. Those Campers in groups will be kept in their groups as much as possible. Campers coming as individuals or couples will be joined up, based on the adventure they chose to do, with others to form a group, as appropriate to provide the best odds for success and for a great experience.
- Do you need to be present at the award ceremony to win the prizes? Yes.

FISHING FAQS

- Are we allowed to have 4 in a fishing boat (plus a dog)? Yes, so long as everyone is comfortable. Safety is the primary concern.
- *Is live bait available at the lodge or is there a store nearby to get bait?* Yes. We have live bait on-site.
- Is a fishing net provided to land the fish? Yes.

- Do we need to provide our own gas for the boat? Yes. It will start as a full tank and you will buy gas to replenish the tank at the Trappers Landing marina.
- Is Fishing Gear available? Yes, it is included at no additional charge.
- Where do we clean fish? Fish Cleaning and storage facilities are on site at the Marina. Fishing cleaning is available for a charge.

HUNTING FAQS

- Do I need a license to fish, hunt ducks or hunt grouse? Yes. You will need to purchase licenses in advance of your arrival on-line or at a license dealer at least one day before hunting grouse or ducks, or before fishing.
- Do I need a pheasant license? No. Preserve pheasant hunting, which is our planned adventure, does not require a pheasant license.
- Is hunting ammo provided? No. No ammo is provided. Each person is responsible for their own ammo.
- What type of hunting ammo is acceptable? Lead or steel shot? Lead is acceptable at the preserve, but steel is required for the waterfowl and grouse hunting on federal lands.
- Is orange clothing or hat required for pheasant or grouse hunting? Yes
- Are the grouse farm-raised grouse released for the grouse hunt? No. The grouse are in the wild on public lands.
- What gun will I get to use? A gun will be selected for you and assigned to you. The serial number assigned you will become the gun that we will receive back from you at the end of the Camp.
- Where do we clean birds? Pheasants will be cleaned for you at the preserve. Grouse, ducks and fish will be cleaned at the marina cleaning site. Game Cleaning and storage facilities are on site at the Marina.

ADMINISTRATIVE FAQS

- Maps will be provided for hunting areas and for driving to activities.
- Safety is first. We will cover basic safety rules before Camp begins.
- No alcohol maybe consumed before or during any activity involving firearms.
- Each Adventure will have a Leader. That Leader will be available in the lodge and cell phone numbers will be provided.
- Sales, lodging and resort taxes are charged additionally on the \$535 fee per person.
- Cancellation penalties of 50% of the Camp Fee per person will apply if cancellation occurs less than 30 days before the Camp begins.
